REQUEST FOR THE INCLUSION OF AN ADDITIONAL SUB-ITEM IN THE AGENDA OF THE THIRTY-EIGHTH SESSION

APPOINTMENT OF A MEMBER OF THE INTERNATIONAL CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION

Note by the Secretary-General

1. Agenda item 17 of the thirty-eighth session of the General Assembly (Appointments to fill vacancies in subsidiary organs and other appointments) does not include a sub-item relating to the appointment of members of the International Civil Service Commission since no term of office is to expire at the end of 1983.
2. However, one member of the International Civil Service Commission has resigned. The General Assembly will therefore have to appoint a member of that Commission.
3. The Secretary-General accordingly suggests that the General Assembly should include in the agenda of its thirty-eighth session an additional sub-item of item 17 reading as follows:

 "(i) Appointment of a member of the International Civil Service Commission."
4. The Secretary-General also suggests that the General Assembly should, in accordance with established practice, allocate the additional sub-item to the Fifth Committee.
