ELECTIONS TO FILL VACANCIES IN SUBSIDIARY ORGANS

Election of twelve members of the World Food Council

Note by the Secretary-General

1. The General Assembly, in paragraph 8 of its resolution 3348 (XXIX) of 17 December 1974, decided that the World Food Council should consist of 36 members to be nominated by the Economic and Social Council and elected by the Assembly for a term of three years, taking into consideration balanced geographical representation, with one third of the members retiring every year and the retiring members being eligible for re-election. The term of the following members expires on 31 December 1983:

Argentina, Egypt, France, Haiti, Hungary, Indonesia, Italy, Japan, Norway, Pakistan, Rwanda and Zaire.

2. By its decisions 1983/161 and 1983/179 of 25 May and 28 July 1983, the Economic and Social Council, acting in pursuance of paragraph 8 of General Assembly resolution 3348 (XXIX), decided to nominate the following States for election by the Assembly to membership of the World Food Council:

- (a) African States (3 vacancies): Burundi, Central African Republic and Morocco
- (b) Asian States (3 vacancies): Indonesia, Iraq, Japan, Pakistan, Philippines and Sri Lanka
- (c) Latin American States (2 vacancies): Argentina and Chile
- (d) Socialist States of Eastern Europe (1 vacancy): Hungary
- (e) Western Europe and other States (3 vacancies): Finland, France and Italy.
