Further report on the status of the cease-fire  
in the Middle East

The following information has been received from the Chief of Staff of UNTSO regarding the situation in the Israel-Syria sector on 25 April 1974:

1. Reports on ground activity:

(a) Patrol 32 (AMR 2345-3054), 1/ Patrol 38 (AMR 2395-3040) and Patrol 41 (AMR 2353-3005): Between 0631 2/ and 0802, between 0859 and 0916, between 0929 and 1000 and between 1150 and 1435 artillery fire, between 1035 and 1258 mortar fire and between 1319 and 1320 rocket fire by Syrian forces. Between 0649 and 0717, between 0945 and 1022 and between 1035 and 1608 artillery fire by Israel forces. Between 1500 and 1520 artillery fire by Syrian forces.

(b) Patrol 36 (AMR 2347-3126): Between 0737 and 1430 artillery fire and between 1302 and 1306 rocket fire by Syrian forces. Between 0800 and 1430 artillery fire by Israel forces.

(c) OP Three (AMR 2308-2678), OP Four (AMR 2327-2596) and OP Uniform (AMR 2366-2621): Between 0800 and 1005 and between 1325 and 1545 artillery fire and between 0800 and 0801, between 0835 and 0945 and between 1105 and 1120 mortar fire by Syrian forces. Between 0825 and 1120 and between 1330 and 1600 artillery fire by Israel forces.

(d) Patrol 33 (AMR 2444-2814): Between 1519 and 1655 artillery fire and between 1536 and 1553 mortar fire by Israel forces. Between 1533 and 1632 artillery fire and between 1558 and 1603 tank fire by Syrian forces.

(e) Patrol 42 (AMR 2431-2961): Between 1520 and 1609 artillery fire by Israel forces.

(f) OP Romeo (AMR 2294-2459): Between 1534 and 1543 artillery fire by Syrian forces. Between 1832 and 1834 and between 1933 and 1935 mortar fire by unidentified forces west-north-west of OP.

2. Firing on or close to United Nations installations:

Patrol 41 (AMR 2367-3026): Between 1042 and 1106 Syrian rocket fire impacted within 15 metres of the patrol location. No injuries to personnel were reported, but a United Nations jeep was damaged by shrapnel.
