Further report on the status of the cease-fire  
in the Middle East

The following information has been received from the Acting Chief of Staff of UNTSO with regard to the situation in the Israel-Lebanon sector on 27 January 1974:

1. Reports on ground activity:

(a) OP Ras: 1/ Between 0505 2/ and 1537 Israel forces personnel and vehicle reoccupied position at AMR 1907-2749 3/ north of border pillar 19.

(b) OP Hin: Between 0525 and 1445 Israel forces personnel and vehicles reoccupied position at AMR 1799-2788 near border pillar 11.

(c) OP Mar: Between 0600 and 1600 Israel forces personnel reoccupied position at AMR 2004-2904 west of border pillar 33.

2. Reports on air activity:

OP Lab: Between 1318 and 1329 two Israel forces jet aircraft, flying west to east, crossed armistice demarcation line west of OP and recrossed armistice demarcation line east of OP (six overflights).

3. Complaints by the parties:

A complaint has been received from Lebanon alleging that on 27 January between 1200 and 1205 two Israel forces jet aircraft overflew the Lebanese regions of Naqoura (AMR 1629-2805) and Sour (AMR 1690-2970).

The above complaint was not confirmed by United Nations observation. However, OP Lab heard air activity overhead but could not report further information owing to weather conditions.
