Further report on the status of the cease-fire
in the Middle East

The Chief of Staff of UNTSO has reported that, in addition to the recurrent incursions near border pillars 11, 19 and 33 (S/11057/Add.424, para. 2), the following developments took place in the Israel-Lebanon sector on 11 May 1974:

1. Reports on ground activity:

OP Lab: 1/ Between 1658 2/ and 1702 machine-gun and small-arms fire by Israel forces across the armistice demarcation line (ADL).

2. Complaints by the parties:

Complaints have been received from Lebanon alleging that:

On 10 May:

- (i) Between 1115 and 1145 the vicinities of the Lebanese villages of El Khraibe (AMR 2104-3048), 3/ Abou Qamah (AMR 2120-3095), Chouaiya (AMR 2172-3110), Hasbjiya (AMR 2147-3115), Mimes (AMR 2170-3035), Mazraat Sfine (AMR 2193-3175) and Marj Ez Zhour (AMR 2197-3188) came under rocket fire from Israel forces jet aircraft. Material damage was reported.
- (ii) Between 1230 and 1300 artillery fire from Israel territory fell in the vicinity of Chebsa (AMR 2200-3055), Rachaiya El Foukhar (AMR 2127-3065) and Mrah Biri (AMR 2183-3086), causing casualties and material damage.
- (iii) Between 1700 and 1830 one Israel forces warship penetrated into Lebanese territorial waters up to Naqoura several times from approximately three to five kilometres off the coast.
- (iv) Between 1710 and 1830 intermittent automatic weapons and artillery fire

from Israel territory fell in the vicinity of Marouahine (AMR 1760-2792), Jabal Blat (AMR 1775-2798), Quaouzah (AMR 1820-2807), Ramiye (AMR 1795-2795), Yaroun (AMR 1897-2761) and Aitaroun (AMR 1944-2802). Material damage was reported.

On 11 May:

- (v) Between 0250 and 0315 artillery fire coming from Israel territory fell in the vicinity of Kfar Chouba (AMR 2150-3035). Material damage was reported.

Complaint (iv) was confirmed by United Nations observation except for damage (see S/11057/Add.463, para. 1 (b)). Complaint (i) was not confirmed, but may be related to the incident reported in S/11057/Add.463, paragraph 2 (b). The other complaints were not confirmed.
