Further report on the status of the cease-fire
in the Middle East

The Chief of Staff of UNTSO has reported that, in addition to the recurrent incursions near border pillars 11, 19 and 33 (S/11057/Add.424, para. 2), the following developments took place in the Israel-Lebanon sector on 2 June 1974:

1. Reports on ground activity:

(a) OP Hin: 1/ Between 0607 2/ and 1205 eight Israel forces personnel crossed the armistice demarcation line (ADL) at AMR 1733-2775 3/ and worked on the reinforcement of a fence along the ADL (maximum penetration 50 metres). Between 0725 and 1205 eight Israel forces personnel crossed the ADL at AMR 1755-2781 and worked on the reinforcement of a fence along the ADL (maximum penetration 20 metres). Between 1721 and 1728, between 1915 and 1946 and between 2034 and 2039 mortar fire by Israel forces across the ADL. Between 1946 and 1950, between 1959 and 2002, between 2039 and 2040 and between 2055 and 2056 machine-gun fire by Israel forces across the ADL.

(b) OP Mar: Between 1648 and 1703 artillery fire by Israel forces across the ADL. Between 1730 and 1741 mortar fire by Israel forces across the ADL. Between 1816 and 1832 tank fire by Israel forces across the ADL. Between 2050 and 2113 and between 2345 and 2358 artillery and mortar fire by Israel forces across the ADL.

(c) OP Ras: Between 1720 and 1725, between 1739 and 1745 and between 1945 and 1948 machine-gun fire by Israel forces across the ADL. Between 2006 and 2024 mortar fire by Israel forces across the ADL.

(d) OP Khiam: Between 1723 and 1740, between 1742 and 1746 and between 2057 and 2107 artillery fire by Israel forces from Israel-occupied territory into Lebanon.

2. Reports on air activity:

(a) OP Khiam: Between 0719 and 0722 two Israel forces jet aircraft, flying south to north, turning west then south, crossed the ADL south of OP and recrossed it west of OP Hin (confirmed by OPs Mar and Hin).

(b) OP Lab: Between 1340 and 1341 one Israel forces jet aircraft, flying west to east, turning south, was first observed west of OP and recrossed the ADL east of OP.

3. Complaints by the parties:

Complaints have been received from Lebanon alleging that:

- (i) On the night of 1/2 June intermittent automatic weapons and artillery fire from Israel territory fell in the vicinity of Ain Sarqa (AMR 1693-2806), Matmoura (AMR 1705-2793), Alma Ech Chaab (AMR 1675-2786), Yarine (AMR 1723-2789), Salhani (AMR 1787-2815), Rachaf (AMR 1842-2830), Aitaroun (AMR 1944-2802), El Karibe (AMR 2104-3048) and Rachaiya El Foukhar (AMR 2127-3065). Material damage was reported.
- (ii) On 2 June from 0440 to 1610 two Israel forces mechanized patrols penetrated Lebanese territory in the vicinity of Chebaa (AMR 2200-3055) and occupied positions at AMR 2185-3040 and at AMR 2198-3052.
- (iii) On 2 June between 0715 and 0720 two Israel forces jet aircraft overflew the Lebanese regions of El Arkoub, Jezzine (24 kilometres north-north-west of OP Khiam, Nabatiye (AMR 1958-3090) and Ett Taibe (AMR 1988-2977).

Complaint (i) was confirmed by United Nations observation except for damage for that portion within observation range of OPs Hin and Khiam (see S/11057/Add.506, para. 1 (a) and (b)). Complaint (iii) was confirmed (see para. 2 (a) above). Complaint (ii) was not confirmed; the area of the alleged incident was not within observation range of OPs.
