Further report on the status of the cease-fire
in the Middle East

The Chief of Staff of UNTSO has submitted the following report regarding the situation in the Israel-Lebanon sector on 21 June 1974:

1. There was no air activity on 21 June. Ground activity, consisting of sporadic artillery and mortar fire by Israel forces across the armistice demarcation line (ADL), was observed in the vicinity of OP Lab, 1/ OP Hin and OP Ras between 0225 2/ and 0347 and in the vicinity of OP Lab, OP Hin, OP Ras and OP Khiam between 1619 and 1935.
2. A complaint has been received from the Lebanese authorities alleging that during the night of 20/21 June intermittent artillery fire from Israel territory fell in the vicinity of Jijim (AMR 1684-2807), 3/ Ain Zarga (AMR 1693-2806), Hair Harfa (AMR 1705-2811), Ej Jibbain (AMR 1724-2806), Aalma Ech Chaab (AMR 1675-2786), Yarine (AMR 1723-2789), Aita Ech Chaab (AMR 1815-2780), Rmaich (AMR 1847-2760), Yaroun (AMR 1897-2761), Haddathe (AMR 1868-2855), Hanine (AMR 1860-2792), Rabb Et Talatine (AMR 1988-2949), Mazraat Dharjate (AMR 2112-3013) and Maissat (AMR 2080-2964). Material damage was reported.
3. The above complaint was confirmed by United Nations observation, except for damage, for that portion within the observation range of OP Lab, OP Hin and OP Ras (see para. 1 above).
