I. Annex

*Amend paragraph 6 to read:*

“6. Ad Article 29 of the Convention

Paragraph 2

This paragraph to read as follows:

‘The road markings shall be white. The term “white” includes shades of silver or light grey. However:

- markings showing places where parking is subject **to some conditions or restrictions** may be blue;’

(rest of text unchanged).”
