In accordance with recommendations 37 (a), (b) and (c) of the Buenos Aires Plan of Action for Promoting and Implementing Technical Cooperation among Developing Countries, as endorsed by the General Assembly in its resolution 33/134 of 19 December 1978, and with Committee decision 11/1 A (paras. 11-13), the Administrator of the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) will submit to the Committee a report on the progress made in implementing the tasks entrusted to the United Nations development system by the Buenos Aires Plan of Action. The report, prepared by the Special Unit for Technical Cooperation among Developing Countries, provides an assessment of progress made in the implementation of technical cooperation among developing countries on the basis of the biennial progress reports submitted by the organizations of the United Nations development system and the responses of some Governments of both developed and developing countries, as well as intergovernmental organizations on their activities to support and promote technical cooperation among developing countries. That report is prepared in response to paragraph 10 of Committee decision 7/5 concerning the submission to Committee sessions of a single document containing an analysis of the information provided by Governments and organizations with conclusions and recommendations, as appropriate.

In addition, the General Assembly, in its resolution 49/96 of 19 December 1994, requested the Committee to consider new directions for technical cooperation among developing countries at its ninth session. The Committee considered the subject and endorsed the recommendations contained in the report on new directions for technical cooperation among developing countries (TCDC/9/3), which was later endorsed by the General Assembly in its resolution 50/119 of 20 December 1995. In accordance with paragraph 19 of Committee decision 11/1 B, the report submitted by the Administrator to the Committee will also assess progress on implementation of the new directions strategy.

The Committee will also consider relevant organizational and supportive arrangements for technical cooperation among developing countries, such as administrative, legal, informational and financial arrangements.
