REPORT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL CONCERNING THE CREDENTIALS OF
THE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND
NORTHERN IRELAND ON THE SECURITY COUNCIL

Pursuant to rule 15 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General wishes to report that he has received a letter dated 14 August 1973 from the Secretary of State for Foreign and Commonwealth Affairs of the United Kingdom, stating that Her Majesty's Government in the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland has designated Sir Donald Maitland, C.M.G., O.B.E., as Permanent Representative of the United Kingdom to the United Nations and instructed him to represent Her Majesty's Government in all organs of the United Nations.

In the view of the Secretary-General, this letter authorizes Sir Donald Maitland to represent the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland at the meetings of the Security Council as duly accredited representative, in accordance with rule 13 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council.

Accordingly, in the opinion of the Secretary-General, these credentials are in order.
