LETTER DATED 3 OCTOBER 1983 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE  
OF NICARAGUA TO THE UNITED NATIONS TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE  
SECURITY COUNCIL

I have the honour to transmit to you the text of a note sent to His Excellency Mr. Fidel Chávez Mena, Minister for Foreign Affairs of El Salvador, by Her Excellency Dr. Nora Astorga, Acting Minister for Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Nicaragua, dated 28 September 1983.

"Sir,

I have the honour to inform you of the following:

On 26 September 1983, a Truk Comander crop-spraying aircraft, Nicaraguan registration YNB-RJ, was stolen from Los Brasiles Airport by the pilot, Yamil Frech Miranda. According to information in our possession, the aircraft was flown to El Salvador and landed at San Miguel.

In view of the criminal nature of this act, the Government of Nicaragua requests the co-operation of the Government of El Salvador in apprehending Frech Miranda and returning the aircraft, in order that it may recover its property.

Accept, Sir, the assurances of my highest consideration.
