LETTER DATED 27 JANUARY 1972 FROM THE REPRESENTATIVES OF CAMEROON, CONGO, EGYPT, EQUATORIAL GUINEA, ETHIOPIA, GABON, GHANA, KENYA, LIBERIA, MALAWI, MAURITANIA, MAURITIUS, MOROCCO, NIGERIA, SENEGAL, TUNISIA, UGANDA, TANZANIA, ZAIRE AND ZAMBIA ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

We, the undersigned representatives, have the honour, under instructions from our Governments to request that we be permitted, in accordance with rule 37 of the rules of procedure of the Security Council, to participate, without a right to vote, in the current session of the Security Council in Addis Ababa devoted to the "Consideration of questions relating to Africa with which the Security Council is currently seized and the implementation of the Council's relevant resolutions".
