Letter dated 27 April 1983 from the Permanent Representative of
the Islamic Republic of Iran to the United Nations addressed to
the Secretary-General

Upon instructions from my Government, and further to our letters of 22 April (A/38/165-S/15729) and of 26 April (A/38/167-S/15735) 1983, I have the honour to inform you that the Pol-e-Dokhtar region of Iran was attacked by Iraqi missiles on 25 April. During this attack, 21 innocent civilians were martyred and 100 more wounded. It is evident that if urgent action in condemnation of these savage crimes is not taken by the international community in general and the Security Council in particular we shall witness more of these war crimes, which are in fact encouraged by the indifference of the Council.

In order to register one more case to the already substantial file of the recorded Iraqi crimes, it will be highly appreciated if this note is distributed as a document of the General Assembly, under item 64 of the preliminary list, and of the Security Council.
