Letter dated 24 October 1988 from Mr. Frank Chapman, National Alliance against Racist and Political Repression, addressed to the Chairman of the Special Political Committee*

New York

On behalf of the National Alliance against Racist and Political Repression, I respectfully request to appear before the Special Political Committee during its 9-10 November hearings on South Africa.

Our organization, with 28 branches and over 60 affiliates across the United States, has struggled for the 15 years since our founding to free Nelson Mandela and all South African political prisoners and to end United States Government support for apartheid and the repression that inevitably accompanies such a policy.

We request time on the agenda of your upcoming session because we are especially concerned about the growth of repression in South Africa and the dramatic escalation of the number of people facing execution.
