LETTER DATED 27 JANUARY 1970 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF
JORDAN TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

Israel's latest systematic and indiscriminate attacks against civilian centres in Jordanian villages and cities caused the loss of innocent lives and destruction of property.

The attached photographs reveal Israel's campaign of terror against civilians and their means of livelihood. Scores of innocent women and children, as some of the pictures depict, were the victims of such brutal, deliberate Israeli attacks.

Upon instructions from my Government, I have the honour to request the distribution of this letter together with the attached photographs as a document of the General Assembly and the Security Council.

It will be appreciated if this matter will be brought to the attention of the Commission on the Status of Women.

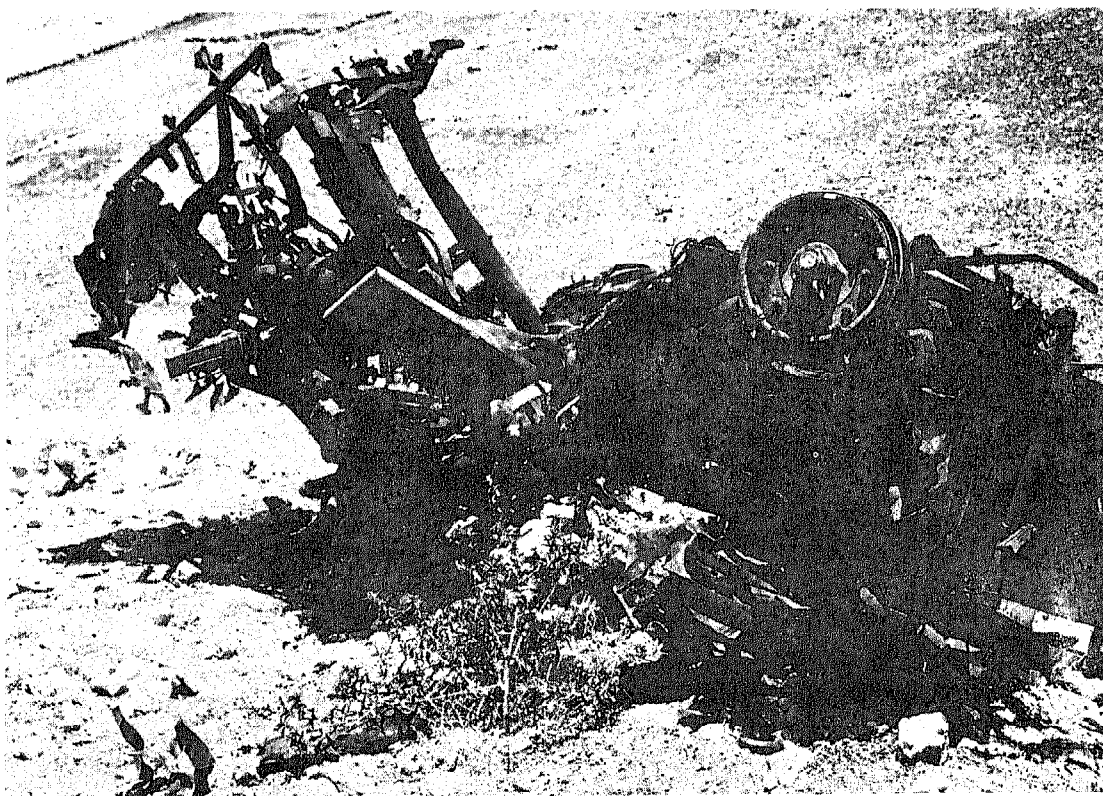


In the same raid against Kufr Asad, a small village,
Israel's napalm bombs had no mercy.

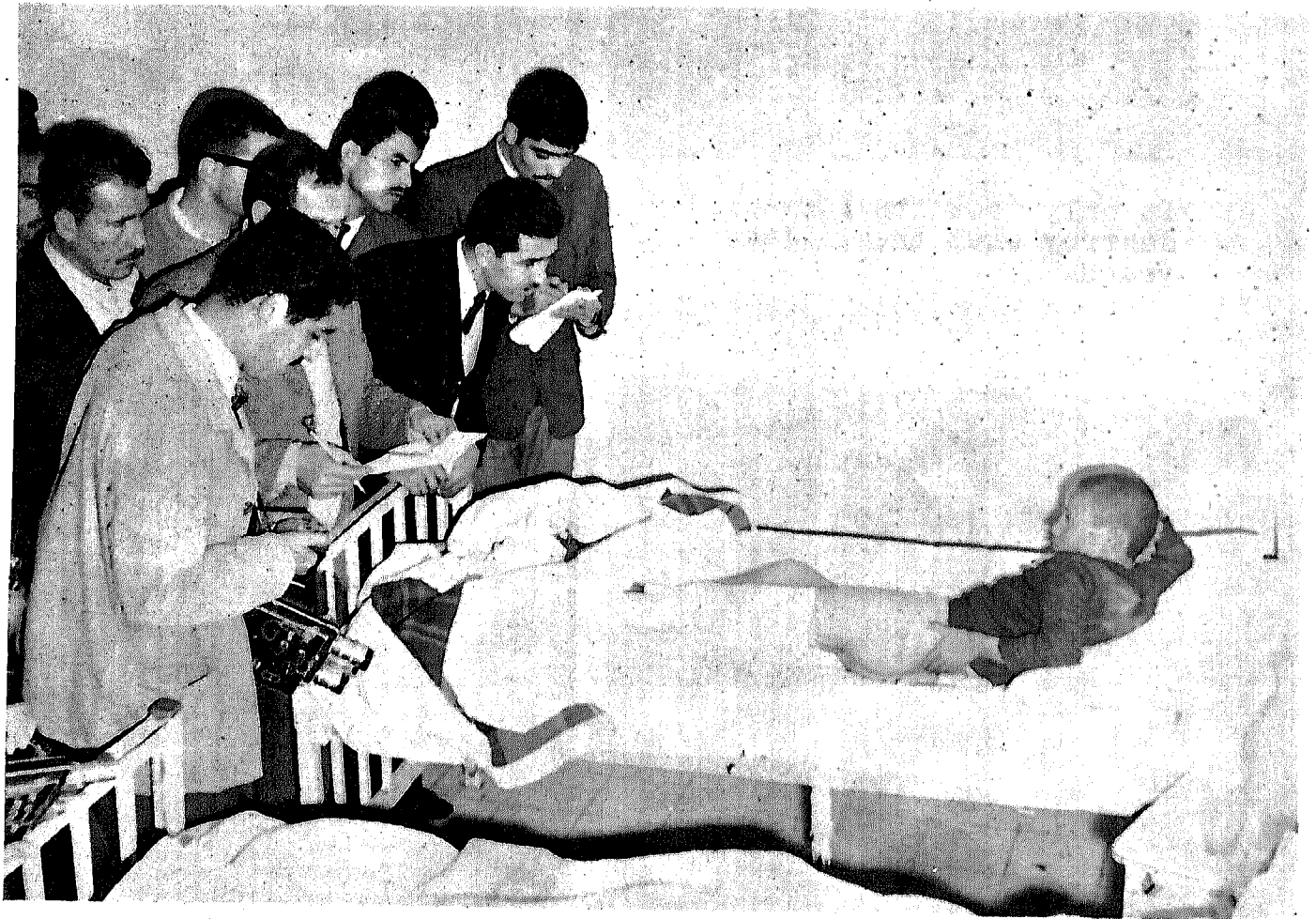




It only took the Israeli jets and shellings minutes to destroy what the villagers of Kufr Asad have built for years.



A boy in the city of Irbid, casualty of Israeli shelling



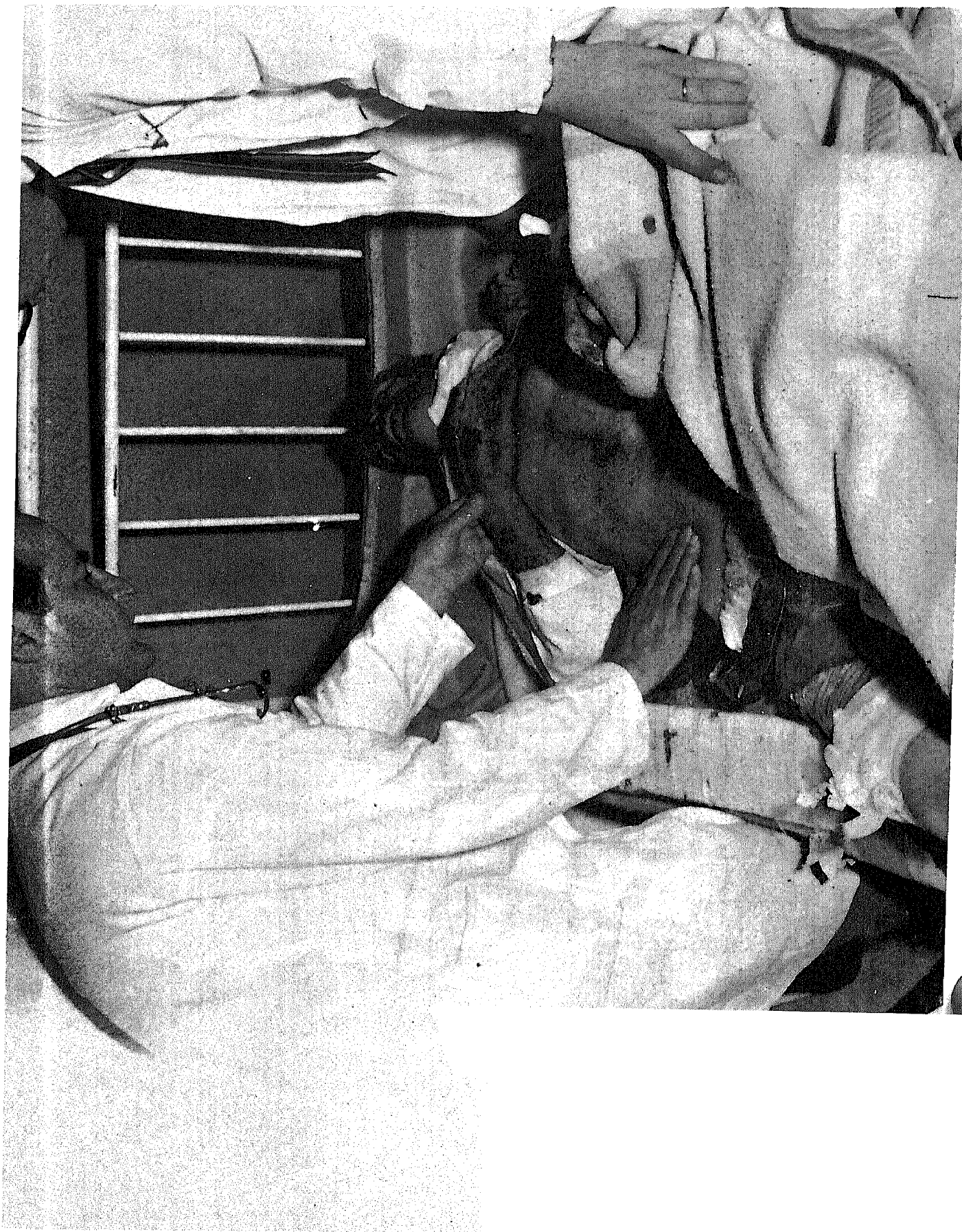
Another boy, casualty of another Israeli attack
