Draft provisional programme of work of the Second Committee for 2004

The General Assembly:

(a) Approves the draft provisional programme of work of the Second Committee for 2004 as set out in the annex to the present decision and agrees to revert to the issue of the programme of work at its fifty-ninth session;

(b) Invites the Bureau of the Second Committee to continue its efforts in consultation with Member States towards ensuring a more practical and coherent organization of the Committee's work, allowing better focus, visibility and participation, in accordance with General Assembly resolution 57/270 B of 23 June 2003, and to make suggestions regarding a decision thereon to be taken at the next organizational meeting of the Committee.

1. Macroeconomic policy questions:
 - (a) International trade and development;
