Letter dated 28 February 2003 from the President of the Economic and Social Council addressed to the Secretary-General (continued) (E/2003/12)

1. **The Chairman** recalled that the Council at its previous meeting had decided to postpone the appointment of members of the Committee on Negotiations with Intergovernmental Agencies in order to give interested delegations more time to indicate their desire to participate. In addition to the countries listed in his letter dated 28 February 2003 addressed to the Secretary-General (E/2003/12), Chile, Ethiopia, Malaysia, Nigeria, Senegal and South Africa had subsequently requested membership in the Committee and Gambia, Indonesia, Mexico and Morocco had expressed interest in participating as observers.
2. If there was no objection, he would take it that the Council wished to take note of the letter contained in document E/2003/12, as orally revised.
