Addendum

Subsequent to the issuance of document S/7432 the following information has been received from the Chief of Staff of the United Nations Truce Supervision Organization:

"1. A witness from El Aal village stated to the investigating UNMOS on 15 July that after the air attack was finished on 14 July, she had come out of her house and seen 'a young boy (Ishmael Hamed, six years old, from the Wadi village North of El Aal) lying on the road there where the bloodstain is.' The witness added that a man picked the boy up and said he would take him to his parents. She had later heard the boy was dead and had been buried on 15 July.

2. The interrogating UNMOS were shown a brown stain on an asphalt road with an area approximately six square feet (see para. 5 of S/7432), allegedly the point where the boy was wounded.

3. The body was not seen by the UNMOS. The Syrian delegation was later requested to obtain the death certificates for the dead woman and for the boy who was stated by the witness to have died. Death certificates for the woman and boy were supplied and were attached to the investigation report."
