LETTER DATED 24 OCTOBER 1966 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF CAMBODIA  
ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

On instructions from my Government, I have the honour to bring to your attention, for the information of the members of the Security Council, the following further acts of aggression and provocation committed against Cambodia by soldiers of the United States-South Viet-Nameese forces.

On 12 September 1966, at about 10 a.m., soldiers of the United States-South Viet-Nameese forces fired several bursts with automatic weapons at Khmer farmers working in the fields approximately 200 metres inside the demarcation line, in the village of Trapeang Daun Boeuf, Khum of Ta On, Srok of Kirivong (Takéo).

On 16 September 1966, at about 10 a.m., soldiers of the United States-South Viet-Nameese forces from the post of Ca-Vang (Chau Doc) directed mortar fire at Khmer territory and five shells fell near the Peam Montea post of the Provincial Guard, in the Srok of Kompong Trabek (Prey Véng), injuring the wife and one child of the Provincial Guard named Tea Buth.

On 17 September 1966, at about 9.35 p.m., soldiers of the same United States-South Viet-Nameese forces from the post of Kinh Thay Bang (Chau Doc) directed several rounds of 105 mm cannon fire at Khmer territory. Nine shells fell approximately 100 metres inside the demarcation line, in the Khum of Sampeou-Poun and at a point approximately 12 kilometres from the centre of the Srok of Koh Thom (Kandal).

On 18 September 1966, at about 7.15 a.m., other soldiers of the same forces, when travelling along the frontier, fired several bursts with automatic weapons at Khmer territory, seriously wounding a girl who was approximately 200 metres inside the frontier, in the Khum of Koh Sampeou, Srok of Peam Chor (Prey Véng).

The Royal Government has registered a strong protest against these acts of aggression deliberately committed by regular troops of the United States-South Viet-Nameese forces and has demanded that the Government of the United States

of America and the Government of the Republic of Viet-Nam put an end forthwith to such criminal acts.

I should be obliged if you would have the text of this communication circulated as a document of the Security Council.
