REPORT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL ON THE SITUATION
IN THE DOMINICAN REPUBLIC

Addendum

1. The following information on the situation in the Dominican Republic up to 24 June 1966 has been received from the office of my Representative there since the publication of my last report on the subject (S/7338/Add.2) on 22 June 1966.

Election of 1 June 1966

2. In a ceremony on 22 June at the temporary residence of Dr. Joaquín Balaguer in Jarabacoa, the Secretary of the Central Electoral Board delivered to Dr. Balaguer and to Francisco Augusto Lora certificates of the Board confirming their election as President and Vice-President of the Dominican Republic, respectively.

3. Arrangements for the ceremonies of installation of the new government on 1 July 1966 have been made public in Santo Domingo. The National Congress is to be installed at 1030 hours on that day, and Dr. Balaguer and Mr. Lora are scheduled to be sworn in before the National Assembly at the National Palace at 1145 hours.

Other developments

4. The Minister for Foreign Affairs, Mr. C.F. Pérez y Pérez, left Santo Domingo for Washington on 22 June to lead his country's delegation to the session of the Tenth Meeting of Consultation of Foreign Ministers of the Organization of American States on 24 June. The meeting was to discuss the request of the Dominican provisional Government for the withdrawal of the Inter-American Peace Force from the territory of the Republic.
