REPORT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY
COUNCIL CONCERNING THE CREDENTIALS OF THE REPRESENTATIVE AND
ALTERNATE REPRESENTATIVES OF THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF NIGERIA ON
THE SECURITY COUNCIL

Pursuant to rule 15 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General wishes to report that he has received a letter dated 21 December 1965 from the Minister of External Affairs of the Federal Republic of Nigeria, stating that Chief S.O. Adebo has been appointed representative of the Federal Republic of Nigeria on the Security Council. Mr. J.T.F. Iyalla and Mr. B.A. Clark have been appointed alternate representatives.

In the opinion of the Secretary-General, these credentials are in order.
