NOTE VERBALE DATED 28 MARCH 1966 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE
OF THE PHILIPPINES ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Secretary of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of the Philippines presents his compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and, with reference to the Secretary-General's notes No. TR 300 SORII and No. PO 230 SORH (1) concerning General Assembly resolution 2022 (XX) of 5 November 1965, and Security Council resolution 217 of 20 November 1965, respectively, on Southern Rhodesia, has the honour to inform the Secretary-General that the Philippine Government has complied with the pertinent provisions of the above-mentioned resolutions intended to bring Southern Rhodesia's illegal régime to an end. Specifically, the Philippines has not recognized the illegal authority in Southern Rhodesia nor entered into diplomatic, economic or other relations with the latter.

It would be appreciated if this note could be circulated as an official document of the General Assembly and of the Security Council.
