REPORT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL
CONCERNING THE CREDENTIALS OF THE ALTERNATE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE UNION
OF SOVIET SOCIALIST REPUBLICS ON THE SECURITY COUNCIL

Pursuant to rule 15 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General wishes to report that he has received a Note dated 30 March 1966 from the Acting Permanent Representative of the Union of Soviet Socialist Republic to the United Nations, stating that his Government has appointed Mr. Nikolai Panteleimonovich Kulebyakin as an Alternate Representative of the USSR on the Security Council.

In the opinion of the Secretary-General, this Note constitutes adequate provisional credentials.
