A. PROPOSAL

The proposed new paragraphs 12.1.3. and 12.1.3.1., should be deleted

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B. JUSTIFICATION

This paragraph introduces requirements which mean that every vehicle manufactured must comply with these PTI requirements from 24 months after the official entry into force of Supplement 3. The corresponding amendment to Regulation No. 13 (documents TRANS/WP.29/930 and TRANS/WP.29/961) applied the same requirements to new approvals only; but did not apply any limitation on the validity of old type approvals.
