## THE NATIONAL REPORT ON ILLEGAL LOGGING

(Prepared by the Department of Forestry and Natural Resource Policy, Norway)

### Summary

Based on available information, illegal logging does not happen to any great extent in Norway. During recent years, there has been only one conviction as result of illegal logging. This was about tree logging on an area subject to provisional protection. Few hard facts are available as to the extent of trade in products of illegal logging. Norway co-operates with other countries, both bilaterally and multilaterally, with the aim of combating illegal logging and trade in timber and timber products of illegal origin.
