LETTER DATED 13 MAY 1966 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF
JORDAN ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

I have the honour to refer to my letter dated 2 May 1966, document S/7275, addressed to Your Excellency, in which I brought to the attention of the Security Council a flagrant violation of the Armistice Agreement by Israel at midnight on 29/30 April 1966. At that time, Israeli regular armed forces launched an unprovoked, vicious attack on the village of Rafat, the Sheikh Hussein police station and the farmers' houses in that vicinity.

In my letter I stated that according to the information available at that time, at least eight civilians were killed and several seriously injured and twenty-three houses blown up. I have now been officially informed that the number of farmers killed as a result of the above-mentioned Israeli attacks has now risen to eleven.

It would be appreciated if my letter is circulated as an official document of the Security Council.
