1. At its 33rd meeting, on 17 November 1988, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/43/32) on the programme budget implications of the draft decision recommended by the Second Committee in paragraph 25 of its report (A/43/750/Add.2). The related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions was presented orally by its Chairman.

2. A statement was made by the representative of the United States of America in the course of the Committee's consideration of this item and is reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/43/SR.33).

DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

3. The Fifth Committee decided, without a vote, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt the draft decision recommended by the Second Committee in paragraph 25 of its report (A/43/750/Add.2), an additional appropriation of \$39,000 would be required under section 1 of the programme budget for the biennium 1988-1989.

4. The representative of Mozambique expressed the appreciation of his Government.
