REPORT OF THE SECRETARY-GENERAL TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY
COUNCIL CONCERNING THE CREDENTIALS OF THE REPRESENTATIVE OF BELGIUM
TO THE SECURITY COUNCIL

Pursuant to rules 14 and 15 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General wishes to report that he has received a telegram dated 9 January 1961 from the Minister for Foreign Affairs of Belgium, stating that Mr. Walter Loridan has been appointed representative of Belgium to the Security Council at meetings called at the request of the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics to consider the question relating to the Republic of the Congo.

In the opinion of the Secretary-General, this telegram constitutes adequate credentials.
