REPORT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL
CONCERNING THE CREDENTIALS OF THE REPRESENTATIVE OF BELGIUM TO THE
SECURITY COUNCIL

Pursuant to rules 14 and 15 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General wishes to report that he has received a telegram dated 1 July 1960 from the Acting Minister for Foreign Affairs of Belgium appointing Mr. Walter Loridan to represent Belgium at the meeting of the Security Council considering the application of the Republic of the Congo for admission to membership in the United Nations.

In the opinion of the Secretary-General, this telegram constitutes adequate provisional credentials.
