Subject: **Host country travel regulations**

1. The Secretariat has received from the United States Mission to the United Nations a note verbale dated 10 February 2005 in which it informs the Secretariat that restrictions on the personal travel of Libyan nationals employed by the United Nations and their dependants have been removed in their entirety.
2. The text of the note verbale is set out in the annex to the present circular.

Note verbale dated 10 February 2005 from the United States Mission to the United Nations

The United States Mission to the United Nations presents its compliments to the United Nations Secretariat and wishes to inform the latter of a change affecting the personal travel of United Nations staff members of Libyan nationality and their dependants.

Travel restrictions imposed on the members of the Permanent Mission of the Libyan Arab Jamahiriya and their families in 1981 and on United Nations staff members of Libyan nationality and their dependants, and subsequently modified over the course of the last 23 years, are to be removed in their entirety effective upon receipt of the present diplomatic note.
