Letter dated 11 March 2005 from the Permanent Representative of Cuba to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General

I have the honour to refer to document S/2005/15 of 25 February 2005, which contains the summary statement by the Secretary-General on matters of which the Security Council is seized and on the stage reached in their consideration.

6. Letter dated 31 December 1960 from the Minister for External Affairs of Cuba addressed to the President of the Security Council (S/4605).

28. Letter dated 2 February 1990 from the Permanent Representative of Cuba to the United Nations addressed to the President of the Security Council (S/21120).
