**Draft conclusions proposed by the Chair**

1. The Subsidiary Body for Scientific and Technological Advice (SBSTA) recalled decision 13/CP.7.
2. The SBSTA further recalled that, at its twentieth session, in taking a next step in implementing decision 13/CP.7, it requested the secretariat to provide information on options for using web-based approaches for sharing experience and exchanging information.
3. The SBSTA considered document FCCC/SBSTA/2004/INF.10 prepared by the secretariat and the use of information on policies and measures of Parties included in Annex I to the Convention (Annex I Parties) that may address, inter alia, the questions identified in paragraph 31 of the above document, and the use of information from international and intergovernmental organizations such as the Organization of the Petroleum Exporting Countries (OPEC) and the United Nations Convention on Trade and Development (UNCTAD).
4. The SBSTA requested the secretariat to upgrade the UNFCCC web page on “good practices” in policies and measures of Annex I Parties by creating links to:
  - (a) UNFCCC web pages on activities relating to Annex I Party national communications, such as preparation of national communications, compilation and synthesis reports, in-depth review reports, a summary of information from all in-depth review reports and summaries from individual in-depth review reports
  - (b) Additional information provided by Annex I Parties regarding their policies and measures, to the extent that new resources are made available by interested Annex I Parties. Any such additional information shall be limited to information provided by Parties, and governmental agencies or departments, and by international and intergovernmental organizations referred to in document FCCC/SBSTA/2004/INF.10. Parties may agree on additions to these links at a later session

- (c) [External data sources with information on policies and measures of Annex I Parties that will address, inter alia, the questions identified in paragraph 31 of document FCCC/SBSTA/2004/INF.10, such as information from international and intergovernmental organizations, including OPEC and UNCTAD.]
- 5. The SBSTA decided to consider this agenda item at its twenty-second session (May 2005).
