Letter dated 3 May 2005 from the Chairman of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1373 (2001) concerning counter-terrorism addressed to the President of the Security Council

I refer to the letter of 23 October 2003 transmitting the third report of the former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia submitted to the Counter-Terrorism Committee pursuant to paragraph 6 of resolution 1373 (2001).
