Paragraph 10

The paragraph should read

10. In 1977 the Secretary-General received 92 governmental nominations for individual human rights fellowships. The Secretary-General has attempted to ensure a broad distribution of the fellowships among the nationalities of the applicants. In 1977, with the financial resources available, recommendations were made for the award of 14 individual fellowships to candidates from the following countries: Benin, Chad, Cuba, Cyprus, Guatemala, Jordan, Kenya, Liberia, Mali, Mongolia, Portugal, Senegal, United Republic of Tanzania, Zambia.
