ANNEX

Letter dated 30 June 1977 from the President of the Republic of  
Djibouti to the Secretary-General

The Republic of Djibouti, having acceded on 27 June 1977 to full and complete independence, is desirous of assuming in their entirety the new international responsibilities which are incumbent on it and of lending its co-operation to the activities of the United Nations community. The Government of the Republic of Djibouti has accordingly decided to seek the immediate admission of the Republic of Djibouti to membership in the United Nations.

I therefore have the honour to request you, on behalf of my Government, to submit the application of the Republic of Djibouti to the Security Council for its consideration with a view to obtaining the recommendation upon which, in accordance with Article 4 of the Charter of the United Nations, the decision of the General Assembly must be based.

Declaration

The Government of the Republic of Djibouti hereby declares that it accepts the obligations contained in the Charter of the United Nations and is able to carry out those obligations. It gives its solemn undertaking faithfully and conscientiously so to do.
