NOTE DATED 28 SEPTEMBER 1955 FROM THE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE UNITED STATES ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL CONCERNING THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE CHANGE IN COMMAND OF THE MILITARY FORCES MADE AVAILABLE TO THE UNIFIED COMMAND PURSUANT TO THE SECURITY COUNCIL RESOLUTION OF 7 JULY 1950 (S/1586)

The Representative of the United States of America to the United Nations presents his compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and has the honor to refer to the Representative's note UN-2459/193 of May 13, 1955 advising that General Lyman L. Lemnitzer would replace General Maxwell B. Taylor as the Commanding General of the Military Forces which Members of the United Nations have made available to the Unified Command under the United States, pursuant to the Security Council Resolution of July 7, 1950 (S/1583).

The Representative of the United States has the honor to inform the Secretary-General that the effective date of the change in command was June 5, 1955.
