## II. Comments received from Governments

### Russian Federation

[Original: English]

#### *Operative paragraph 2*

1. After the second sentence, the following new sentence should be inserted: “In this respect, we recommend that the Commission on Crime Prevention and Criminal Justice request that the United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime prepare a draft of a United Nations convention on extradition and mutual legal assistance.”

#### *Operative paragraph 17*

2. The operative paragraph should read as follows:

“17. We call upon Member States to conclude as soon as possible the ongoing negotiation of the draft comprehensive convention on international terrorism. We also urge Member States to sign and ratify as soon as possible the International Convention for the Suppression of Acts of Nuclear Terrorism, in order to ensure the speedy entry into force and subsequent implementation of this first pre-emptive antiterrorist instrument, which is crucial to international efforts aimed at not allowing terrorists to have access to nuclear weapons and related materials.”
