Admission of new Members to the United Nations**Letter dated 22 June 2006 from the President of the Security Council addressed to the Secretary-General**

I have the honour to request that you transmit to the sixtieth session of the General Assembly the following resolution of the Security Council (resolution 1691 (2006)) on the admission of the Republic of Montenegro to membership in the United Nations, adopted by the Security Council at its 5473rd meeting on 22 June 2006:

“The Security Council,

“Having examined the application of the Republic of Montenegro for admission to the United Nations (A/60/890-S/2006/409),

“Recommends to the General Assembly that the Republic of Montenegro be admitted to membership in the United Nations.”

In accordance with rule 60, paragraph 2, of the Council's provisional rules of procedure, I also request that you transmit to the sixtieth session of the General Assembly, for its information, the verbatim records of the 5471st and 5473rd meetings of the Security Council, at which the application of the Republic of Montenegro was considered.
