International Labour Organisation - Letter dated 13 April 1951 from the
Director-General of the International Labour Office.

The Governing Body of the International Labour Office at its 114th Session noted the decision of the Council inviting such of the specialized agencies as feel directly concerned with the proposed economic, social and cultural rights to send representatives to the Seventh Session of the Commission on Human Rights to participate in the work of the Commission relating to economic, social and cultural rights, and which also calls upon the Commission to take such steps as are necessary in order to obtain the fullest co-operation of the specialized agencies in the consideration of economic, social and cultural rights, and to consider for this purpose the setting up of one or more joint working groups consisting of representatives of the Commission and of the interested specialized agencies which will report to the Commission.

The Governing Body accordingly decided to appoint a tripartite delegation including one member from each group which would be available for consultation in connection with the drafting of articles on economic and social rights within the competence of the I.L.O., and which would represent the I.L.O. on any joint working party with the Commission on Human Rights which may be set up to draft such articles. In accordance with this decision of the Governing Body, the following representatives of the International Labour Organisation would be available to take part in any joint working group which may be established by the Commission on Human Rights:
