3. Proposals to revise UNECE Standards

(a) Early and Ware Potatoes

A Working Group on Early and Ware Potatoes was set up by the Specialized Section at its 2006 session and is composed of representatives from Belgium, France (rapporteur), Germany, Netherlands, the United States and Europatat. They will present the results of their discussions on the application and further development of the standard on potatoes adopted by the Working Party in 2006.

4. Review of UNECE Recommendations

At its 2006 session, the Working Party adopted the recommendation to delete the paragraph “The cherries must be carefully picked”.

(b) Peaches and Nectarines

The Working Party on Agricultural Quality Standards returned the text for Peaches and Nectarines to the Specialized Section for further work and extended the trial period of the existing recommendation.

The Working Group set up by the Specialized Section and composed of representatives from France, Germany (rapporteur), Italy, South Africa, Spain, Sweden and the United States will present proposals concerning the revision of the standard.

(c) Table Grapes

At its 2006 session the Working Party adopted a section on minimum maturity requirements for the Table Grapes as a UNECE recommendation to be further discussed at the 2007 session of the Specialized Section. Subject to inputs from the OECD Scheme and Codex Alimentarius, other parts of the standard may also be revisited.

(e) Apples

The Working Group of representatives from Belgium, France, Germany, Italy, New Zealand, South Africa, the United States, the European Community (rapporteur) and COPA/COGECA (Committee of Professional Agricultural Organisations / General Confederation of Agricultural Co-operatives in the European Union) will report on the results of its work to develop a practical and easy-to-understand approach to uniformity. The Working Group was asked by the Specialized Section to take into consideration the fixed-sized charts from COPA/COGECA and the output of the September 2006 meeting of the Codex Alimentarius Committee on Fresh Fruit and Vegetables.

5. Amendments to the general texts
