#### Appointment of the members of the Committee on Conferences

##### Note by the Secretary-General

1. In resolution 38/32 B of 25 November 1983, the General Assembly requested the President of the Assembly, after consultations with the chairmen of the regional groups, to appoint 22 Member States, on the basis of an equitable geographical balance, to serve on the Committee on Conferences for a three-year term.
2. By a communication of 1 March 1984, the President of the General Assembly informed the Secretary-General that, following consultations with the chairmen of the regional groups, he had appointed the following 22 States as members of the Committee on Conferences:
