Addendum 2

Draft amendments to the ATP adopted at the sixty-second session

The secretariat reproduces below the text of the draft amendments to the ATP Agreement adopted by the Working Party at the sixty-second session and to be transmitted to the depositary.

Annex 1, appendix 1, of ATP

At the end of paragraph 6, add the following text:

“For insulated bodies, the identification marks shall be on the outside of the body. The identification marks of the thermal appliance shall be clearly legible and fixed in a readily accessible location not requiring the equipment to be dismantled by means of tools. This requirement shall apply to new vehicles only. A transitional period of one year shall be granted from the date this requirement enters into force.”

Add a new paragraph 7:

“7. Technical requirements for the test stations:

The test stations designated or approved by the competent authority to perform the tests specified in Annex 1, Appendix 2, paragraphs 7 to 27, 32 to 47 and 51 to 59 will comply with the requirements of the standard ISO-17025. A transitional period of one year will be granted from the time this requirement enters into force.”
