Institution-building of the Human Rights Council and draft Code of Conduct for Special Procedures Mandate-holders of the Human Rights Council (A/HRC/5/L.2 and L.3/Rev.1)

1. The PRESIDENT said that agreement had been reached on a text entitled “United Nations Human Rights Council: Institution-building” (A/HRC/5/L.2) which was based on the informal paper that he had introduced at the 8th meeting, on the understanding that it also included the draft Code of Conduct for Special Procedures Mandate-holders of the Human Rights Council (A/HRC/5/L.3/Rev.1), which had likewise been introduced at the 8th meeting. If he heard no objection, he would take it that the Council accepted the combined text.

2. It was so decided.

Postponement of action on all pending draft proposals

3. The PRESIDENT suggested that the Council should take action on all pending draft proposals, including the package that had just been agreed, at an organizational meeting to be held the following day.

4. It was so decided.
