Sweden: Amendments to article II of the draft Convention (E/794)

In this Convention genocide means any of the following acts committed with the intent to destroy, in whole or in part, a national, ethical, racial, religious or political group, on grounds of the national or racial origin, religious belief, or political opinion of its members;

1. Killing members of the group;
2. Impairing the physical integrity of members of the group;
3. Inflicting on members of the group measures or conditions of life aimed at causing their deaths;
4. Imposing measures intended to prevent births within the group.
