The Committee is expected to consider, in accordance with the relevant procedures, any referrals made by the secretariat concerning possible non-compliance by individual Parties with their obligations under the Convention, as provided for under paragraph 17 of the annex to decision I/7.

Item 7. Communications from members of the public

The Committee is mandated to consider, in accordance with the relevant procedures, communications from the public, as provided for under chapter VI of the annex to decision I/7.

(a) The Committee is expected to consider any new information received with regard to communications ACCC/C/2005/15 (Romania), ACCC/C/2006/18 (Denmark), ACCC/C/2007/19 (United Kingdom) and ACCC/C/2007/20 (Kazakhstan).

(b) The Committee is expected to resume its preparation of draft findings and, if appropriate, recommendations with respect to communication ACCC/C/2006/16 (Lithuania).

(c) The Committee is expected to discuss the content of communication ACCC/C/2006/17 (European Community). In accordance with chapter IX of the annex to decision I/7 of the Meeting of the Parties, the Party concerned and the communicant are entitled to participate in the discussion on the subject matter of the communication, though not in the preparation or adoption of any findings, measures or recommendations of the Committee.

(d) The Committee will discuss any new communications received sufficiently in advance of the meeting, in particular with respect to their admissibility and any issues that may need to be raised with the Party concerned.

(e) The Committee may discuss any other issues related to communications.
