LETTER FROM THE IRANIAN AMBASSADOR TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL
DATED 9 APRIL 1946

Sir,

Permit me to thank you for your note of 8 April, 1946,,
forwarding for my information a copy of Mr. Gromyko's letter
dated 6 April 1946, requesting that the questions brought to the
attention of the Security Council of Iran be removed from the agenda.

I am instructed to state that the position of the Iranian
Government remains the same as stated to the Security Council in the
session of 4 April 1946. It is the desire of my Government that
the matters referred by Iran to the Security Council remain on its
agenda as provided by the resolution adopted on 4 April 1946.
