## **Summary statement by the Secretary-General on matters of which the Security Council is seized and on the stage reached in their consideration**

### **Addendum**

Pursuant to rule 11 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, and in accordance with paragraph 7 of the note by the President dated 19 December 2007 (S/2007/749), the Secretary-General is submitting the following summary statement.

The complete list of items of which the Security Council was seized as at 1 March 2008 is contained in document S/2008/10/Add.8 of 5 March 2008.

The present addendum lists the items on which the Security Council took action during the week ending 8 March 2008. The dates given for each item indicate when the item was first taken up by the Council at a formal meeting, and the most recent formal meeting of the Council held on that item.

### **Non-proliferation** (29 March 2006; 3 March 2008)

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 5848th meeting, held on 3 March 2008. The Council, under rule 37 of its provisional rules of procedure, invited the representatives of Germany and the Islamic Republic of Iran, at their request, to participate in the consideration of the item without the right to vote. The Council proceeded to vote on draft resolution S/2008/141, submitted by France, Germany and the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, which received 14 votes in favour (Belgium, Burkina Faso, China, Costa Rica, Croatia, France, Italy, Libyan Arab Jamahiriya, Panama, Russian Federation, South Africa, United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, United States of America, Viet Nam), none against and 1 abstention (Indonesia), and was adopted as resolution 1803 (2008).
