REPORT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE
SECURITY COUNCIL CONCERNING THE CREDENTIALS OF THE
REPRESENTATIVES OF BELGIUM ON THE SECURITY COUNCIL

Pursuant to rule 15 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General wishes to report that he has received a letter dated 3 November 1954 from the Minister for Foreign Affairs of Belgium stating that Mr. Fernand van Langenhove has been appointed representative of Belgium on the Security Council and that Mr. Joseph Nisot has been appointed alternate representative of Belgium on the Security Council.
