REPORT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY  
COUNCIL CONCERNING THE CREDENTIALS OF THE REPRESENTATIVE OF  
CANADA TO THE SECURITY COUNCIL

Pursuant to rules 14 and 15 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General wishes to report that he has received a letter dated 15 July 1958 from the Chargé d'Affaires ad interim of Canada, transmitting a message from the Secretary of State for External Affairs of Canada in which it is stated that, during the temporary absence of Mr. Charles S. Ritchie, Mr. John W. Holmes, Assistant Under-Secretary of State for External Affairs, will act as Canadian Representative to the Security Council until further notification.

In the opinion of the Secretary-General, this letter constitutes adequate provisional credentials.
