EXPULSION OF ALIENS

Addendum

B. Consideration of the topic at the present session, paragraphs 5 to 5 *bis*

Insert the following text after “Mr. McRae”:

5. [...] in order to consider the issues raised by the expulsion of persons having dual or multiple nationality and by denationalization in relation to expulsion.

5 *bis*. At the end of its meeting on 14 July 2008, the Working Group concluded that the commentary to the draft articles should indicate that, for the purposes of the draft articles, the principle of the non-expulsion of nationals applies also to persons who have legally

acquired one or several other nationalities. The Group also agreed to include in the commentary wording to make it clear that States should not use denationalization as a means of circumventing their obligations under the principle of the non-expulsion of nationals. The Chairman of the Working Group presented the Group's conclusions to the Commission at the latter's [2984th] meeting on [24] July 2008. The Commission approved those conclusions and requested the Drafting Committee to take them into consideration in its work.
